This year's offering will involve the Cobourg Legion Pipes and Drums and the Concert Band of Cobourg presenting appropriately themed instrument and voice tunes, along with Legion Colour Guard and local Cadet Forces participation. You may recall the last such concert that the CLP&D shared with the Cobourg community in 2019. The "Highway of Heroes Concert" was our well-received offering of thanks to our veterans and serving members of the RCA, RCAF and the RCN. We will again recognize in music and word the contributions of our armed forces. Moneys raised will be given in support of Royal Canadian Legion programming.
